Linda Brookman, RDHAP, MS

Linda Brookman is an Associate Professor of Clinical Dentistry in the Division of Dental Public Health & Pediatric Dentistry at the Herman

Ostrow School of Dentistry of USC. She is the Co-director of the Neighborhood Mobile Dental Van Program where she supervises students who provide preventive oral health services to low-income children in inner-city elementary schools in Los Angeles. Professor Brookman also supervises dental hygiene students in the Geriatric Mobile Dental Unit at Hollenbeck Skilled Nursing facility for ten years. She is integrating Teledentistry into both of these programs. Prof. Brookman is also an educator in the Community Oral Health Online Master's Program, directing four graduate level courses.

Anna Pattison RDH, MS

Anna Pattison is a former Associate Professor and Chair of Dental Hygiene at the Ostrow School of Dentistry at USC. She is coauthor of *Periodontal Instrumentation* and

has contributed to Carranza's Clinical Periodontology. She was Editor-in-Chief of Dimensions of Dental Hygiene and is now Co-Director of the Pattison Institute which offers online videos, lectures and hands on workshops. An internationally recognized speaker on Advanced Periodontal Instrumentation, in 2005, she received the Pfizer-ADHA Excellence in Dental Hygiene Award and the USC School of Dentistry Alumnus of the Year Award. In 2006 she received the California Society of Periodontists Award and in 2010 she was inducted into the USC School of Dentistry Hall of Fame.

Parish P. Sedghizadeh, DDS, MS

Dr. Parish P. Sedghizadeh is an Associate Professor of Clinical Dentistry at the University of Southern California, Herman Ostrow School of Dentistry. He serves as the Section Chair of Diagnostic

Sciences. Dr. Sedghizadeh is a clinical and surgical oral and maxillofacial pathologist and Director of the Oral Pathology and Radiology distance learning program at the Ostrow School of Dentistry. As a clinician-scientist, Dr. Sedghizadeh conducts research, publishes, consults, and teaches oral pathology and oral medicine with an active intramural clinical practice. He has over 80 peer-reviewed publications, and his research laboratory and clinical research projects focus on the characterization and treatment of microbial biofilm infections, particularly osteomyelitis and osteonecrosis of the jaw where he has developed and tested novel bisphosphonate-antibiotic conjugates to target bone infections.

Jeffery A. Goad, Pharm D., MPH

Jeff Goad is Professor and Chair of the Department of Pharmacy Practice in the Chapman University School of Pharmacy. He received his Doctor of Pharmacy degree from the USC School of Pharmacy and Masters of

Public Health from the Keck School of Medicine of USC. He completed a residency in pediatric pharmacy practice at Childrens Hospital Los Angeles and holds the Certificate of Knowledge in Travel Health from the International Society of Travel Medicine. For more than 20 years, Dr. Goad has maintained an active practice in university Travel Health clinics and immunization services. He coordinates and teaches courses in travel medicine, immunizations, and parasitology. He is currently a national faculty and advisory board member for the American Pharmacists Association Pharmacy Based Immunization Training Program and Chair of the APHA Travel Medicine Advanced Competency Training Course. He has presented at over 200 pharmacy and medical conferences and published more than 80 articles and book chapters. Dr. Goad is the past Chair and co-founder of the International Society of Travel Medicine's Pharmacist Professional Group and past President for the California Immunization Coalition and California Pharmacists Association. He is currently a member of the Governor appointed California COVID Vaccine Drafting Guidelines Workgroup.

Topic: COVID-19 Vaccine- What you need to know!

Course Overview

With the developments related to COVID 19, there is a need to provide new ways of providing care including offerings of teledentistry, recognition of oral manifestations of the virus, providing alternatives to ultrasonic scaling and even in the ability to scientifically discuss the various vaccines available.

COVID-19 and Periodontal Therapy

Topics to be covered:

- New hand instruments to reinvigorate your hand instrumentation techniques while avoiding fatigue and improving effectiveness and COVID infection control products.
- Current information regarding COVID-19 vaccines. To include research regarding efficacy of the 2 vaccines against COVID-19 and the recent variants plus myths vs facts.
- Oral findings in patients with Covid-19 along and how these findings can relate to disease pathogenesis. Current evidence will be presented, case studies, and a discussion of the clinical significance to dental practice.
- How COVID-19 has created the need for remote office visits. There will be a discussion about the role of the dental hygienist and the importance of interprofessional collaborative practice. Steps for implementing a plan to create an interdisciplinary team will be presented.

Upon completion participants will be able to:

- Identify optimal new hand instruments fo periodontal non surgical therapy.
- Identify myths versus facts about the COVID vaccinations
- Describe the findings and oral manifestations of the COVID virus
- Discuss the role of the Dental Hygienist in utilizing teledentistry
