Standard 2-3 Admissions

The intent of this standard reads: "The dental hygiene education curriculum is a postsecondary scientifically-oriented program which is rigorous and intensive. Because enrollment is limited by facility capacity, special program admissions criteria and procedures are necessary to ensure that students are selected who have the potential for successfully completing the program. The program administrator and faculty, in cooperation with appropriate institutional personnel, should establish admissions procedures which are non-discriminatory and ensure the quality of the program."

Additionally, this standard requires the institution's policy on discrimination.

Standard 2-15 Patient Care Competencies

This standard states: "Graduates must be competent in interpersonal and communication skills to effectively interact with diverse population groups and other members of the health care team": With the intent stating: "Dental hygienists should be able to effectively communicate with individuals, groups and other health care providers. The ability to communicate verbally and in written form is basic to the safe and effective provision of oral health services for diverse populations. Dental Hygienists should recognize the cultural influences, impacting the delivery of health services to individuals and communities."
