#### Instructor - Dental Hygiene

The College of Southern Nevada (CSN), Department of Dental Sciences, Diagnostic Evaluation and Rehabilitation Services is currently seeking a full-time tenure track Dental Hygiene Instructor to begin in Fall semester 2022. Teaching assignments may include day, evening, weekend, in class, online, and/or hybrid classes in accordance with department needs.

Under the direction of the Department Chair, The Dental Hygiene Instructor will be responsible, but is not limited to the following:

- Provide didactic instruction in the Baccalaureate programs- may include nights, weekends, and off-campus rotation sites.
- Provide clinical and lab instruction in the BSDH Direct Admit program
- Attend program meetings including faculty meetings, program review, and faculty in-service development programs or trainings, any of which may include nights and weekends.
- Maintain 5 office hours for student advisement and remediation, per CSN Policy.
- Participate in college-wide-committees or events
- Participate in community service and program committee assignments, which may include nights and weekends.
- Utilize various forms of online learning technology in teaching methodology.
- Support the goals, missions, and core values of the dental hygiene program by building good relations through clear communication with the director, faculty, staff, and students.

#### Required Qualifications

- Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene degree from a regionally accredited College or University awarded before January 1, 2022, AND accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation.
- Applicants must be currently enrolled or been awarded a master's degree in either Dental Hygiene, Education, Higher Education, Public Health, OR equivalent degree in a health-related profession from a regionally accredited College or University. Consideration will be given to BSDH degree applicants who have begun a master's degree program by the fall of 2021.
- Provide evidence of an active Nevada Dental Hygiene license with local anesthesia and nitrous oxide permits. If you do not currently hold an active Nevada license with local anesthesia and nitrous oxide permits, please note that receiving an active license may take up to 3 months to receive. Please see the Nevada State Board of Examiners website for licensing information. <https://dental.nv.gov/>
- Document a minimum of 5 years of full-time equivalent clinical experience practicing Dental Hygiene. One year of experience is equal to 12 months of full-time practice. Part-time experience (a minimum of 2 days a week) for 12 months will be equivalent to 6 months full-time experience. Full-time and Part-time employment must be specified in the description of employment.
- Provide evidence of a current CPR Provider Card/Certificate.
- Membership in the American Dental Hygienists' Association as well as Nevada's state and local component Dental Hygiene Associations or your own state and local component.

#### Preferred Qualifications

- Prior didactic and clinical teaching experience in a Dental Hygiene program.
- Leadership/Management experience in a Dental Hygiene program.
- Experience teaching and/or working with diverse student and staff populations.
- Participation in the student chapter of the American Dental Hygienists' Association

#### Salary Starting Range

Initial salary placement is based on educational level and total years of full-time equivalent teaching experience. For example, for an instructor with a master's degree the salary range would be \$46,691 to \$58,364 annually. The entire salary range is up to \$70,038 annually with a Doctorate and 10 years' experience. A maximum of 10 years of experience will be considered for the initial salary placement
